Sea Foam Sales Company is extremely safety conscious. We want you, your employees, customers, and anyone else who comes into contact with Sea Foam Products to know how to safely handle them.

There are a number of laws designed to protect the health, safety and welfare of the general public as well as certain sectors of the population, such as travelers or employees. While Sea Foam invests a great deal of resources to ensure compliance with such laws, our ultimate goal is to provide safe, effective products.

The California Safe Drinking Water and Toxics Enforcement Act of 1986 (better known as Proposition 65) has two primary objectives:

- (1) Prohibition on contaminating drinking water with chemicals known to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity, and;
- (2) Warning of individuals before exposure to chemicals known to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity.

The proposition protects the state's drinking water sources from being contaminated with chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and requires businesses to inform Californians about exposures to such chemicals.

Proposition 65 requires the state to maintain and update a list of chemicals known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity. If a product contains chemicals on the List, businesses are required to inform Californians about exposures to such chemicals.

With respect to the Proposition 65 List which is referenced in the title of this document, the following Sea Foam product contains chemicals on the List.

Sea Foam Concentrated Fuel Injector Cleaner

Such product will be referred to herein as “Listed Products.” Listed Products require a Prop 65 warning for any sales into California. Reference: <https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65/proposition-65-list>

Effective August 30, 2018, Proposition 65 was amended to also include “pre-purchase” warning requirements. In addition to on-product warnings, catalogs and webpages must now carry the same warnings so that consumers in California can see the warnings prior to purchase.


Sea Foam will provide the necessary warning on the labels of Listed Products, on its websites, and in all future printed publications. Distributors are expected to convey identical warning language in their communications and provide the necessary warning to any downstream seller including retailers or other suppliers to which they are redistributing Sea Foam Listed Products.

For Sea Foam distributors who sell online, the warning language for products sold must be shown to the online consumer prior to completing the purchase, and should also be provided on the product display page with a clearly marked hyperlink using the word "WARNING," or by otherwise prominently displaying the warning to the purchaser prior to completing the purchase, e.g.:
